PhD Position in Finance

JOB QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates should be committed to completing their PhD degree in Finance, and should meet the requirements for the enrolment into the PhD program (see <u>http://www.lancaster.ac.uk/lums/accounting-and-finance/research/phd/</u>). You should also be committed to pursuing an academic career. You should be able to pursue your own independent research programme under the supervision of a team of experienced supervisors. You should have competence to assess and potentially deliver material at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

RESEARCH INTERESTS: We are interested in recruiting a candidate with research interests in asset pricing, corporate finance, financial econometrics, fund management, machine learning, sustainable finance, textual analysis, and other related fields of finance research. APPLICATION PROCEDURE: You should submit your application online at <u>https://hr-jobs.lancs.ac.uk/</u>. The application package must contain a cover letter, CV, degree transcripts for Masters and undergraduate study, two letters of reference (at least one of which should be an academic reference), and examples of academic writing (e.g., research

proposal, research report, Master thesis). We will start screening the applications in the early March and will continue looking for candidates until <u>1st June</u> or until the position is filled. <u>Early applications are strongly encouraged</u>.
